With refer nos to your application on the subject noted above I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi to upgrade of your school from classes middle to secondary (without-Aid) w.e.f. 1996-97 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions -

- That the school shall abide by the provision of Delhi School Education Act and Rules, 1973 framed those under as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
- That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of Caste and Creed and proference shall be given to the students of the area concerned.
- That the School shall appoint more full time qualified and obligible staff for all the classes of the school as per the present terms of the department and the proof should be provided to E.O. for verification.
- That the school shall equip the schence Lab as per the norsm of the Department and suitable ficilities for practical work shall be provided of the students. More material worth Rs.5,000/- shall be purchased during 1996-97 and a list be furnished to the Education Officer for verification.
- That a proper Library shall be astablished and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. More approved standard books shall be purchased. Pooks as per the ratio of 10 books pur student may be added and facilities of reading from may also be provided immediately and more books worth Rs.5,000/be purchased by the start of next session and the list of books are furnished to E.O. for verification.
- That the adequate sports material shall be purchased for out door, games and indoor games during the session.
- That the school shell strictly abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Aules, 1973 and payment shall be made as per section 10(I) of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 to all the employees through crossed chaque and proof should be shown to concerned E.O.
- That the enrollment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated 0 10 p.g.ft. per student for the available flow area of the class room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the tames of the agpartment in each of class. The number of saisting sections should not exceed the number of class room of proper size in the school.

- That the school shall distense with the services of unqualified and everaged staff, if any immediately.
- 12. That all the facilities prescribed under Rules 50 & 51 of the Delhi Education Act, 1973 shall be made available to the students, provision of Rules 6,7 and 9 be strictly observed.
- 13. That the service contract between the management and the employees small be executed immediately.
- 14. That the arrangement of good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students, adequately.
- 15. That the violation of any instructions orders conditions rules and regulations of the department shall lead of the withdrawl of recognition of the school and class XI shall not be op med without the prior approval of the Director of Education, Delhi.
- 16. That the management of the School shall create a Roserve Fund equal to three months salary of the staff in a joint name of the Director of. Education and the Manager of the School in any scheduled Bankw within a month.
